Vocational skills training programme.

In Cameroon it is still difficult to get computer knowledge. Although there are some special computer training schools, it is hard to get in this programmes and the fees are high. To fulfill our objective of providing employability skills to youth, we started a computer training programme in 2007 This programme supports underprivileged people likee AIDS orphans, school drop out girl, women and primary school children. This programme began with an initial support from The Associated Country Women of the World (ACWW) which enabled us to buy 10 refurbished computers. The programme has so far trained and graduated 5 batches of students including women and children. 95 students have already been trained on basic computer application programmes. Six girls have gained employment as secretaries and four have established their own computer documentation places. Children's computer classes are organized during holidays.
